



The 2016 TEDxMHK Challenge

Do you have an idea worth spreading? An idea with the potential to change your workplace, community or the world?

We invite you to take the TEDxMHK Challenge and submit your idea for a chance to give a TEDx talk in Manhattan, KS, on February 1st, 2016.

In 2016, the TEDxMHK is themed after “Fueling Human Existence”. TEDxMHK encourages attendees to see the many different perspectives that fulfill human needs ranging from technology and science to creativity and sustainability.

To participate, 1) submit your original idea in the form of a 2-3 minute video to YouTube, 2) elaborate a clearly written summary. Then, send both the YouTube link and the summary as a message in our Facebook page by **December 7th, 11 pm**. This is an open-ended challenge, anything goes, be creative, be thoughtful. A fancy video isn't necessary — we're interested in your idea.

Prizes: The winner will be invited to share your idea with the TEDxMHK 2015 audience on the stage. Travel to Manhattan, KS , if needed, are covered for the winner.

Eligibility: Open to any age group; must be US residents only.

About TEDxMHK:

Our desire is for this event to become a local forum for ideas within the community that inspire people to connect and change lives, futures and, ultimately, the world in which we live. This year's TEDxMHK encourage attendees to see the different perspectives that fulfill human's needs from technology, sustainability, to science.
